BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

8 1. a. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, 9 during the ¹<u>fall athletic season of the</u>¹ 2020-2021 school year, ¹[the 10 Commissioner of Education shall waive the requirement to complete 11 an annual preparticipation physical examination, as required under 12 section 2 of P.L.2013, c.71 (C.18A:40-41.7), for any student-athlete 13 who completed:

(1) a physical examination in accordance with section 2 of
 P.L.2013, c.71 (C.18A:40-41.7) during the 2019-2020 school year; or

16 (2) a physical examination that allowed the student to participate 17 on a school-sponsored interscholastic or intramural athletic team or 18 squad during the 2019-2020 school year a student-athlete who has not completed a physical examination within 365 days prior to the first 19 20 day of official practice in the athletic season, as required under section 2 of P.L.2013, c.71 (C.18A:40-41.7), shall be permitted to participate 21 in a school-sponsored interscholastic or intramural athletic team or 22 23 squad during that athletic season, provided that the student-athlete 24 completes the physical examination before the end of the athletic season¹², and the parent or guardian of the student-athlete provides 25 proof, before the first day of official practice of the athletic season, 26 27 that the physical examination is scheduled².

b. (1) A student-athlete who ¹[receives a waiver under 28 29 subsection a. of this section, and participates] qualifies for participation¹ on a school-sponsored interscholastic or intramural 30 athletic team or squad during the ¹fall athletic season of the¹ 2020-31 2021 school year ¹[,] under the provisions of subsection a. of this 32 section¹ shall provide the health history update questionnaire required 33 under subsection b. of section 2 of P.L.2013, c.71 (C.18A:40-41.7) 34 before the first day of official practice of 1 [an] the 1 athletic season 35 ¹[in which the student-athlete participates]¹. 36

(2) If the student-athlete answers in the affirmative to any
question included in the health history update questionnaire, then the
student-athlete shall not participate on the school-sponsored
interscholastic or intramural athletic team or squad until he is further
evaluated by the school physician, or if a school physician is not
available, any other licensed physician.

c. As used in this section, "student-athlete" means a studentenrolled in grades six to 12 who participates on a school-sponsored
