## **CHPS Committed to Access**

WE are committed to access across the district, with projects completed, projects in progress, and projects planned. Our Capital Reserve Funds provide the foundational funds for one-time expenses to improve educational spaces, make investments in existing infrastructure and ensure compliance with regulatory requirements. Projects will continue through 2023 and beyond!

Summer 2021: \$636,088 invested via Capital Reserve funds to make Woodcrest and High School West fully accessible through improvements to main entrances and drop off areas.

Summer 2022: \$1,326,703 in current work at Beck and Paine to continue improvements to main entrances and drop off areas.

School Year 2022-2023: \$600,000 refreshment of the Malberg Early Childhood Center Playground with accessible equipment and improved features.

Summer 2023 \$1,550,000 in planned investments to improve Stockton and Lewis main entrances and drop off areas.
